MUSICAL PERFORMANCES

Musical performances refer to the various kinds of groups that perform musical rendition. They range from one person to several tens of people. Below are types of musical performances.

Solo

This refers to one person singing or performing a musical instrument alone.

Duet

This refers to two persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Trio

This refers to three persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Quartet

This refers to four persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Quintet

This refers to five persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Sextet

This refers to six persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Septet

This refers to seven persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Octet

This refers to eight persons singing or performing musical instrument.

Choir

A choir is a group of singers singing together.

Parts of a choir

Soprano: This is the female's high voice.

Alto: This is the female's low voice.

Tenor: This is the male's high voice.

Bass: This is the male's low voice.
