

## TYPES AND APPLICATION OF COLOURS

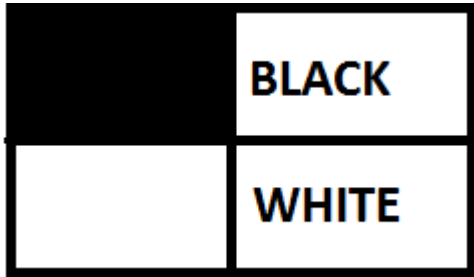
In the previous lesson, we looked at the two major types of colour namely:

1. Primary colours
2. Secondary colours

Let us look at other types of colours:

### Neutral colours

These are colours used for lightening or shading other colours. They are black and white.



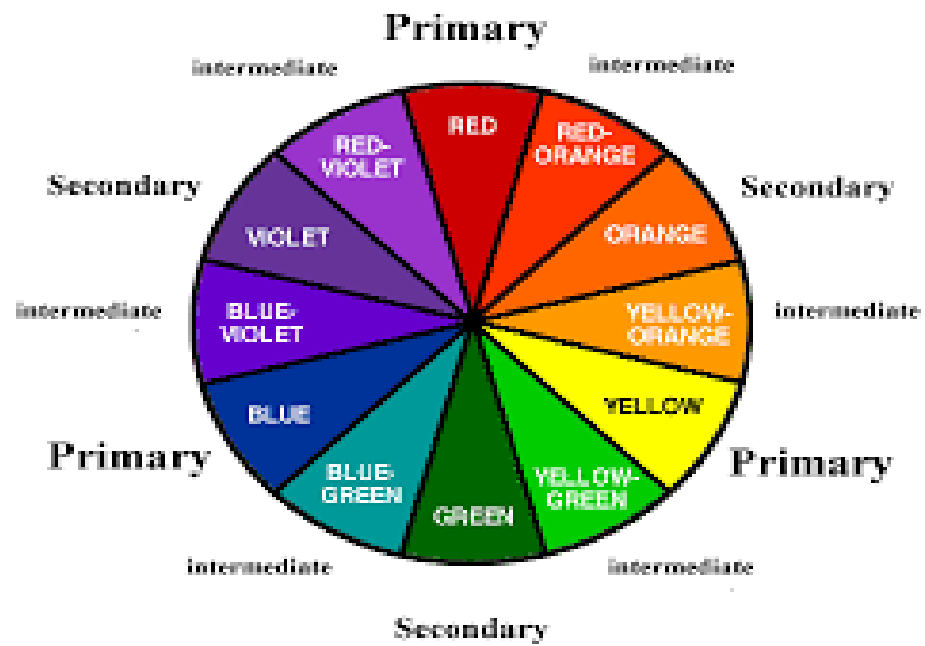
### Tertiary colours

These are colours derived from mixing equal parts of two secondary colours together.



### Intermediate colours

These are colours derived from mixing equal parts of a primary and a secondary colour.



**Analogous colours:** These are colours that set in a row of similar shades in a colour wheel. They actually look similar



**Harmonious colours**

These are colours that agree together.



**Complimentary colours**

These are colours derived from mixing colours that are opposite each other on a colour wheel.
